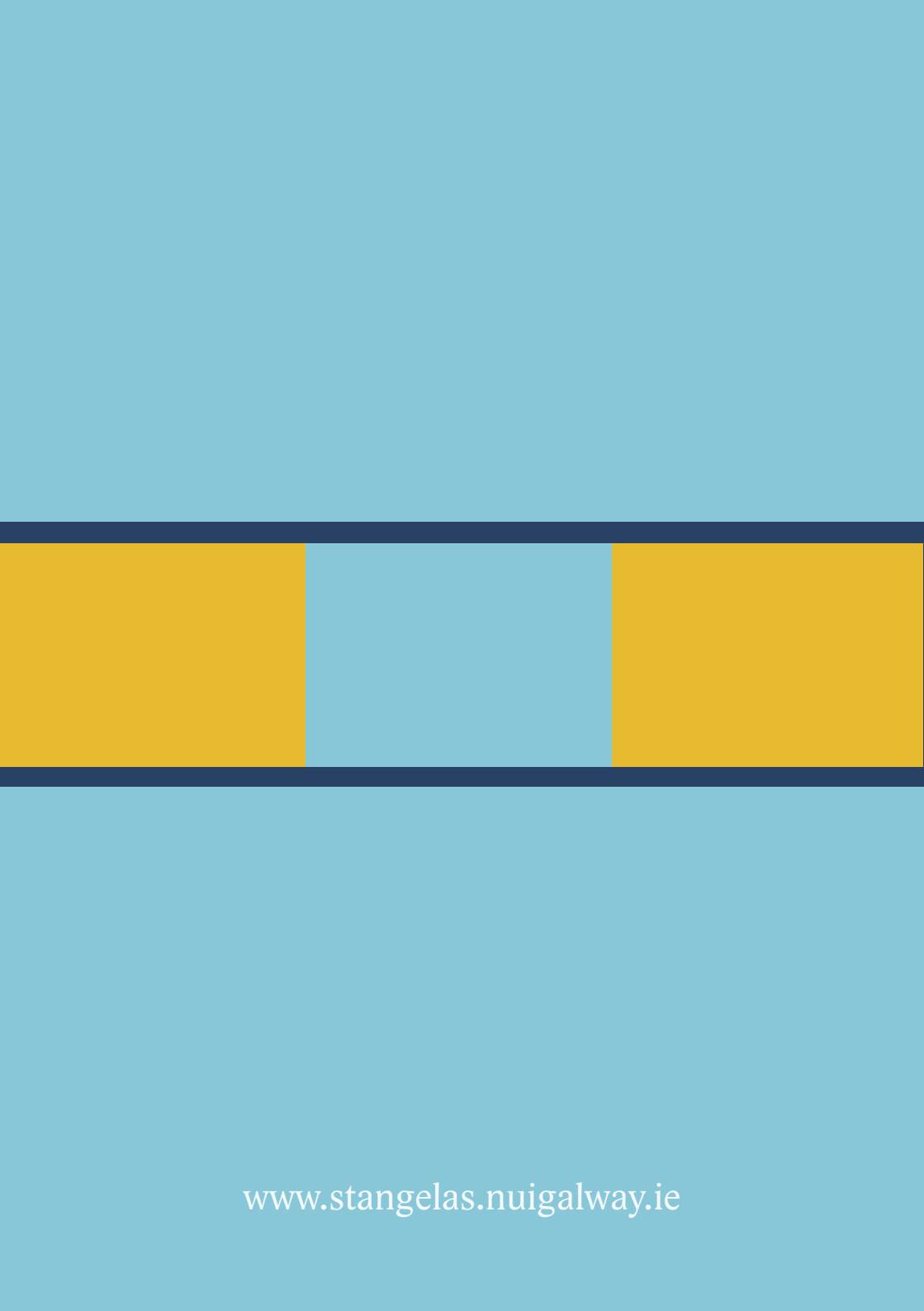

THE CONFERRING CEREMONY

An Searmanas Bronnta

The Academic Secretary opens this University meeting, saying in Latin:

“Right Honourable President and all the University. This University Meeting has been convened today for the purpose of admitting certain people to academic Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates. They will be introduced by Declan Courell.

The President of St. Angela’s College recites the following formula of introduction, in Latin:

“Right Honourable President and all the University. I present to you these my daughters and these my sons whom I know to be, in respect both of character and of learning, fit and proper persons for admission to the Degree/Diploma/Certificate...; and I pledge to thee and to all the Academy my solemn word that so it is.”

And as the President performs the conferring, he says, likewise in Latin:

“And I for my part, with the authority granted me admit thee to the Degree/Diploma/Certificate...”



The wording, in Latin, of the primary Degree parchment is as follows:

“National University of Ireland

This parchment testifies that the degree of ..., the Honours Course having been completed, (i.e. it is an Honours Degree) in St. Angela’s College, Sligo a College of National University of Ireland, Galway, which has been duly established as a partner University of the National University of Ireland, has been conferred on day 01 of the Month of November 2019.”

The parchment is surmounted by the Coat of Arms of the NUI, on the left, in the centre, the Coat of Arms of NUI Galway, and on the right by the Coat of Arms of St. Angela’s College. This reflects the fact that the degree is technically a degree of the federal National University of Ireland, but is awarded, not by the NUI, but by NUI Galway. The NUI Coat of Arms, adopted in 1911, comprise, on a green background, a golden harp, whose forepillar, reflecting an ancient Irish tradition, is constituted by a winged female figure; it is surmounted by a five-pointed star (incorporating a shamrock), representing the Réalt Eolais (Star of Knowledge) and symbolising also the five ancient chieftainries of Ireland. The motto, in Latin, on top is ‘Veritati’ (‘To Truth’) – explaining the purpose to which the University is dedicated – and underneath, in old Irish, ‘Fír Fer’ (‘The Truth of Mankind’) – referring to absolute fairness as the means through which that purpose is to be pursued.

The Coat of Arms of the University, dating from the early days of Queen’s College, Galway, comprise a shield divided into quarters, describing, in increasingly specific terms, the location and purpose of the College. The first quarter, a golden lion on a red background, represents the British Empire; the second quarter, a golden harp on a green background, represents Ireland within that Empire; the third shows the arms of the province of Connacht; and the fourth the arms of the city of Galway. The open blank book in the centre is a standard heraldic symbol for an institution dedicated to learning. The motto on top, in Latin, is ‘Deo Favente’ (‘With God’s Favour’).

The St. Angela’s College Coat of Arms was created in 2006 and incorporates key elements of the Ursuline Coat of Arms. The Ursulines are the Trustees of the College.

The Coat of Arms carries the same shape as the Ursuline Coat of Arms and the traditional Ursuline colours of blue and gold and the latin “Soli Deo Gloria” which means “Glory to God Alone”. The Open Book is a symbol of Education, Teaching and Learning which is the core business of the College. The eight pointed Gold Star is taken from the Ursuline Coat of Arms and symbolises the following; “Those who instruct others unto justice shall shine like stars for all eternity”.

At the foot, the parchment carries the seal of the NUI and is signed by Professor Ciarán Ó hÓgartaigh, President of the NUI, Galway.
